

Online Public Participation for August 6th Kings Local Schools Board of Education Meeting

The Kings Local Board of Education values its engagement with the community and believes that providing an opportunity for public comment during Regular Board Meetings supports that engagement and provides transparency. Though providing an opportunity for public comment is not a requirement, we would like to continue this practice even while meeting virtually. In the spirit of maintaining this opportunity for our public to participate in these virtual school board meetings, interested persons may sign-up to speak via [this form](#). The Board will allow the public participant to sign-up until 4:30 PM, 1 hour prior to the start of the Regular Meetings for inclusion in the meeting.

When signing up to speak through the provided form, please follow these guidelines:

- For this meeting only, we ask all community participants keep their comments on the topic of our meeting: Kings 2020-2021 Reopening Plan
- You only have 3 minutes to speak during the meeting
- You will enter the Zoom meeting and wait in the virtual waiting room until it is your turn to speak
- After your time speaking, you will be asked to leave the meeting
- Refrain from using inappropriate language and/or identifying Kings' staff or students by name
- The person who fills out the form will be the only person allowed to speak during their three minutes and each person may only speak once

All comments submitted become a matter of public record and are subject to release under Ohio law and the federal Freedom of Information Act. As with in-person public participation made during a traditional school board meeting, no person may address or question members individually during the virtual board of education meeting.

After you sign-up to speak, you will be emailed a link to the online Zoom meeting.
